This collection was compiled and maintained from the earliest days of the National Home for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers. The material has been housed in various locations over the years, including inside the various iterations of the hospital, administrative buildings, used in displays, and kept in the warehouses. The final move came out of the Medical Media department, where the appointed local historian had gathered them into one area as best as the space could hold.

The collection moved into the National VA History Center, inventoried with the original custodian, and transferred.

General Notes

National Home for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers or NHDVS usually refers to the larger administration function. The “Home” refers specifically to the Central Branch of the National Home for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers. It is often referred to by these other names: “Dayton Soldiers Home”, “Dayton Military Home”, “National Military Home in Dayton”.

The NHDVS Central Branch was the predecessor organization to the Dayton VA Medical Center (DVAMC). In 1930, the governmental functions regarding veterans were organized under one agency called the Veterans Administration (VA). Locally, the campus was initially referred to as the “VA Home”, and then the “Dayton VA Facility”. In 1946, the term “Dayton VA Center (VAC)”

was adopted, and in 1980 it changed again to “Dayton VA Medical Center”, with “VA” now standing for “Veterans Affairs”, to reflect the new status of the Department of Veterans Affairs as a cabinet-level agency.

There are gaps in the box numbers within series. Those numbers are contained within other series. Due to the way the collection had previously been stored it would have been very difficult to re-sequence the boxes in due order. Now that the collection is processed, that will be easier and done as a renumbering project.

Series Descriptions

National Home for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers

This series consists of administrative material, photos, newspapers, community events, etc. Of interest may be: Army commission and discharge certificates from former residents, Grand Army of the Republic material, letters, theater bills, documentation regarding the decision of Dayton as the site of the home, reports to the Board of Directors, blank letterhead, stereoscope images of the Grotto taken by various commercial enterprises, image engravings, copies of Harper’s Weekly articles and images of the Home, articles from local newspapers and the remaining inventory from the Putman and Thompson libraries. Materials in this collection date from the era of the National Home for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers (pre-1930).

Administrative Materials

This subseries consists of materials pertaining to the management, organization, and communication activities involved in the day-to-day running of the Central Branch. It includes communications to leadership in DC; and a biography of Col. Edwin F. Brown, first governor of the Central Branch of the NHDVS. Of particular interest: a letter from Dayton Electric Company, regarding bringing electricity to the campus; a letter from Gen. George B. McClellan as part of his duties on the NHDVS Board of Managers. Of interest is a collection of correspondence regarding Home members, officials, etc. from other NHDVS facilities such as the Northwestern Branch (Milwaukee, WI), Southern Branch (Hampton, Va.). Also of special note is a military appointment document signed by William H. Seward, then Governor of the State of New York. Included in this subseries is the Special and General Orders of the Central Branch which record the day-to-day membership changes and activities, orders issued from the Board of Managers to the Homes, and orders from the Home officials to the members.

This subseries consists of images of multiple types, including stereoscopic, photographic, lithographic and etchings. Subject matter includes residents (also referred to as "inmates" or "members"), officers, staff, buildings, the grounds, the Grotto, lakes/ponds/gardens, barracks, and other housing. Of note are the stereoscopic image and postcard collections, taken by multiple private organizations. These images are the best visual representation of life in the early Soldiers Homes. Buildings in this collection are included according to their construction date (1867-1929), regardless of date of photo. Also included are lithographic prints featuring the Central Branch campus as it appeared in the late 1800's.
