COMPUTER MATCHING AGREEMENT BETWEEN

DEFENSE MANPOWER DATA CENTER, DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE AND

VETERANS BENEFITS ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS FOR RESERVE PAY RECONCILIATION CMA #89

Under the applicable provisions of the Privacy Act of 1974 as amended (5 U.S.C. § 552a), a computer matching agreement shall remain in effect for such period, not to exceed 18 months, as the Data Integrity Boards of the participating agencies determine is appropriate. However, the Data Integrity Boards may, without additional review, renew the matching agreement for a current, ongoing matching program for a period not to exceed one additional year if:

- 1. Such program will be conducted without any change; and
- 2. Each party to the agreement certifies to the Boards in writing that the program has been conducted in compliance with the agreement.

This is a one-year renewal of the above-referenced computer matching agreement between the Department of Defense (DoD) (the source agency) and the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), Veterans Benefits Administration (VBA) (the recipient agency), signed by the agencies' respective Data Integrity Boards on April 21, 2021 and April 27, 2021, respectively. Under this matching agreement, VA makes a determination of which individuals are being paid by DoD/U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) for duty performed and are being paid VA disability compensation or pension benefit, and makes award adjustments accordingly.

The following match meets the conditions for renewal:

I. Parties to Match:

II. Purpose of the Agreement:

The purpose of the matching program is to verify eligibility for DoD/USCG members of the Reserve forces who receive VA disability compensation or pension to receive, in lieu and upon election, military pay and allowances when performing reserve duty.
